
MAKING DREAMS COME TRUE

A BRIEF HISTORY


Sumiyoshi Taisha was founded in 211 AD by Empress Jingu, who governed Japan at the time. Due to Osaka being a port city, it has enshrined a trio of sea-faring deities known as Sumiyoshi Sanjin. Thus, many pray for safe travel by sea and successful fishing. Empress Jingu herself was enshrined here after her death and became known as Okinagatarashihime no Mikoto.

Over time, it has become known for the Sumiyoshi Matsuri (Osaka's largest festival), various rites and many traditional performances and has been given the endearing name of 'Sumiyossan'. The beloved shrine is headquarters to 2,300 Sumiyoshi shrines nationwide. Its four main sanctuaries utilize a roofing style called Sumiyoshi-zukuri, used by shrine builders nationwide, and now serves as National Treasures.


The beckoning cats on the cover (¥800 per cat) are sold at Nankun-sha. Cats with raised right hands are beckoning cats that bring money and cats with raised left hands are beckoning cats that attract customers. It is said that continuing to collect them will bring good luck for business development and family safety.
